JSW Energy Ltd. (JSWEL) is a group company of the USD 8 billion O.P.Jindal group. JSWEL is the first Independent Power Producer (IPP) in Karnataka, India. The company currently owns 260 MW and operates & maintains about 550 MW at various locations. JSWEL is planning to expand generation capacity to 15000 MW by 2015. Capacity addition of about 3500 MW is at various stages of completion at different locations. JSWEL is actively pursuing to foray into hydel and transmission sector also.

JSWEL is planning to add 4x800MW supercritical power units adjacent to the upcoming 4x300MW at Ratnagiri in Maharashtra. JSWEL is already in advanced stage of developing the infrastructure for the project. The coal for the project will be sourced from Indonesia.
